Thank you for considering Outwest Adventures LLC for your hunting needs. You have asked for information on our Pronghorn hunt in North Central Colorado. We offer Archery, Muzzleloader, and Rife hunts all of which provide both a challenging and rewarding hunt!

### **Location**

If you choose to book your Pronghorn hunt with us, you will be hunting in units 16/17/171 located in historic Jackson County, CO. This region is comprised of over a million acres and is one of the best units in Colorado to harvest a book goat. With the Arapaho National Wildlife Refuge located less than 20 miles to the north of our ranches there is plenty of open country for the herd to roam. Specifically, you will be hunting just outside of the town of Rand, CO. Rand is located about 3 hours Northwest of Denver at the base of Parkview Mountain at the south end of the North Park Region of Colorado. The North Park Region is surrounded by mountain crests of the Park Range, Medicine Bow Range, and Never Summer Range. This area offers open sagebrush country, willow flat marshes surrounded by aspen, fir, and pine forests all reaching up to elevations beyond the tree line. With breath-taking views of Parkview Mountain to the south, the Never Summer Mountain Range and the Continental Divide to the southeast, and the rugged Buffalo Peaks to the west, you will truly find your place in the world!

### **"The Hunt"**

You will have the opportunity to hunt two private ranches (20,000 acres) Tags in our units are very tough to draw, but we do have a limited number of landowner vouchers available, and due to the very limited draw in these units, there are some giant goats that inhabit the area. All of our hunts take place in the open sage flats and hay fields that fill the valley floor of this area. We do spot and stalk when possible, or offer ground blinds over water holes. This is a perfect option for a combo elk/pronghorn hunt and is perfect those early season elk hunters if they want to hunt elk in the mornings and evenings and hunt pronghorn in the middle of the day and early afternoon.

### **Pricing**

**Hunt: Guided Draw Archery: \$2,500**

**Guided Draw Rifle: \$3,500**

**Landowner Voucher Only (Hunter must have voucher): \$1,500 (This price only allows you trespass rights to hunt the ranch, no lodging included)**

**Elk/Pronghorn Combo Draw Archery: \$3,500**

***\*\*License, airfare, game processing/transportation/taxidermy, and transportation to and from Denver are not included in the price of the hunt***

Hunts are offered as either guided or trespass rights with the Landowner Voucher. Landowner vouchers are typically available in this unit, but each landowner charges their own fee for the voucher, you can expect to pay up to \$1000 for a voucher depending on the landowner and weapon of choice. If guided, it's up to you on how much you would like the guides to work with you. If you are a truly a do-it-yourself hunter, our guides can show you all property boundaries and offer direction on where to start as well as how to hunt the ranches and surrounding BLM/Public Lands. If you would like the full experience, our guides will either sit with you if desired or set you up in a specific ground blind location.

**Deposit:** We require a 50% deposit due to Outwest Adventures LLC within 7 business days of confirming your hunt dates. The balance of your hunt fee is due 60 days prior to your arrival into Rand. Please send all deposits and hunt balance checks to:

*\*\*2012 Big Game Limited Draw Application Deadline is April 3rd, 2012. Big Game Leftover Licenses will be available starting August 14, 2012. You can purchase your license/habitat stamp online (<http://wildlife.state.co.us>) \*\*if purchasing on-line, you must purchase your over the counter license or leftover license by midnight the day before the season your applying for starts, after that they are only available at a DOW Office, by calling the Colorado Department of Wildlife (800-244-5613), or at the Bass Pro Shops located at 7970 Northfield Blvd, Denver, CO 80238 (720-385-3600). It is approx 10 miles west of the Denver International Airport on your way to Rand.*

## Hunter Safety Cards

By Colorado statute, everyone born on or after January 1, 1949 who applies for a Colorado hunting license or preference point *must have successfully completed an approved hunter education course*. Note: If you have a valid hunter education card/certificate from another state, and it can be verified, it will be honored in Colorado. Certifications from other countries may also be accepted.

## Accommodations (Guided and Elk Combo Only)

You will be staying in an authentic ranch house on a historic ranch site. There are several other 1800's cattle operation buildings on site and a pond on which you will see plenty of ducks and geese. The three bedroom house sleeps 6 comfortably. When the weather gets bad, which it will in the later seasons, we have a washer and dryer so you can be as comfortable as possible out in the elements. There is a comfortable living room with Direct TV, a full bathroom with shower, and a kitchen with all the cooking utilities needed to make sure you are well fed. You are responsible to bring your personal grooming effects, towels, washcloths, and bedding. We do offer limited of all, with the exception of personal effects, but most hunters like to bring their own to be as comfortable as possible. If you have special needs or are flying into Denver, please let Jeff know what you will need so we can plan accordingly. There is a phone at the ranch house, but you must purchase calling cards prior to arriving in Rand in order to make outgoing calls, however anyone can call the ranch house to check-in (phone number to be provided after you have booked your hunt). Your cell phone will not work during the week so do not plan that as your form of communication with the outside world. We offer handheld radio's for all our hunters to stay in contact with your guides if you choose to hunt without a guide at your side.

## Game Cleaning/Processing

After the kill, our guides will prepare your pronghorn for processing. All animals will be processed in the field, taken back to the ranch house at which time they will be skinned and caped and made ready for transport to the game processor. We work with a game processor in Granby CO, around 45 miles south of the ranch house. They offer limited custom game processing options and will freeze your game to prepare it for transportation back home. You can purchase dry ice in Winter Park, CO on your way back to Denver. If flying into Denver, the processor can ship your game back home, but it is very expensive as it has to be overnight delivery to get it into your freezer as quickly as possible.

## Weather

From August to November, the weather in this region of Colorado can change in seconds and you may be enjoying a sunny 70 degree day that suddenly turns into a complete blizzard with temperatures down around freezing or below. Layers are the key, so pack accordingly! If you are struggling with what to bring, call Jeff and he will be happy to advise you on clothing, equipment, firearms, and ammo.
