Thank you for considering Outwest Adventures LLC for your hunting needs. You have asked for information on our Goose hunt in Southeastern Colorado.

Location

If you choose to book your Goose hunt with us, you will be hunting on the eastern plains along the Arkansas River in Southeastern Colorado. We have access to large tracts of private lands that hold huge numbers of Snow Geese that winter in Northern Colorado or are headed south in the fall and north in the spring, and what could be better than the beautiful Arkansas River and the plains of eastern Colorado as your backdrop!

“The Hunt”

North Central Colorado Canada Geese: Your World-Class Goose Hunt starts with the right location and features seasoned guides with championship calling abilities that will have you in the geese all day. We use only the best and newest decoys on the market which are used to lure in even the shyest birds. Season dates range from mid-November thru mid-February.

Southeast Colorado Snow/Canada Goose: We have the best ground to hunt in Southeast Colorado, come out and hunt elusive Snow Geese as well as Canada Geese on the Eastern Plains of Colorado. Season dates range from mid-November through mid-March, and we put the hurt on hundreds of Snow Geese and Canada Geese as they make their way south in fall and then back north in late winter/early spring. With most of water fowlers focusing on the spring for Snow Geese, they are missing out on some absolutely awesome hunting in south eastern CO in the regular season as well. Our Decoy spreads consist of 500+/- of Avery GreenHead Gear Full Body Snow Goose Decoys as well as adding 150+/- Avery Greenhead Gear Full Body Canada Goose Decoys to the spread during the regular season to entice the Canada geese as well. In the spring snow goose conservation season there is no limit and we can use electronic callers and have unplugged shot guns.

Ducks: If Duck hunting is your passion, we have over 5 miles of the Arkansas River to hunt. Hunt this sportsman’s paradise over Avery Greenhead Gear floater duck decoys. The prime months to hunt ducks on the Arkansas River are December and January.

Limits: Snow Geese regular season: 20 per person per day

Spring conservation season: No limit

Canada Geese: 4 per person per day

Ducks: Please contact us for limits

Pricing

Hunt: Regular Season - \$250.00 per gun per day. (Minimum of 4 hunters per group required)

Spring Season - \$275.00 per gun per day. (Minimum of 4 hunters per group required)

Ducks - \$225.00 per gun per day. (Minimum of 4 hunters per group required)

Combo - \$200 per gun per day - 3 day hunt package, mix it up with a duck hunt and goose hunt you pick what species to hunt on which days (Must be in consecutive days, minimum of 4 hunters required)

****Food & Lodging, license, state and federal waterfowl stamps, airfare, transportation/taxidermy, and transportation to and from Denver are NOT included in the price of the hunt**

Deposit: We require a 50% deposit due to Outwest Adventures LLC within 7 business days of confirming your hunt dates. The balance of your hunt fee is due 60 days prior to your arrival into Lamar. Please send all deposits and hunt balance checks to:

Hunter Safety Cards

By Colorado statute, everyone born on or after January 1, 1949 who applies for a Colorado hunting license or preference point *must have successfully completed an approved hunter education course*. Note: If you have a valid hunter education card/certificate from another state, and it can be verified, it will be honored in Colorado. Certifications from other countries may also be accepted.

Weather/Recommended Gear List:

From September to March the weather in this region of Colorado can change in seconds and you may be enjoying a sunny 70 degree day that suddenly turns into a complete blizzard with temperatures down around freezing or below. Layers are the key, so pack accordingly! If you are struggling with what to bring, call Jeff and he will be happy to advise you on clothing, equipment, firearms, and ammo, but below is a list of what we recommend:

- Ducks, 12 or 20 ga. #4 or #6 steel shot in 2 3/4" or 3" shells
- Geese 12 or 10 ga. #2 or BB steel shot in 3" or 3 1/2" shot shells
- Warm coveralls or bibs with a warm parka, again dress in layers as the temperature can change from hour to hour.
- Warm boots
- Gloves
